(Citizens from other countries should check with their nearest consulate for document requirements. The same documentation required for travel to Hawaii will be required for the cruise.)

**Proof of CITIZENSHIP consists of the following:**

- Passport (preferred)
- Original or certified copy (with raised seal) of birth certificate
- Certificate of naturalization
- Certificate of citizenship

**Proof of IDENTITY consists of the following** (applicable to everyone 16 years of age and older):

- Valid driver's license that includes a photograph
- Government identification card including photograph and physical description

**Any passenger traveling without proper documentation will be denied boarding, and no refund will be given.**

**PEARL HARBOR • ARIZONA MEMORIAL • HONOLULU CITY HIGHLIGHTS**

**\$165 per person**

Staff will meet group upon arrival at Honolulu's International Airport and assist with luggage. Enjoy a narrated tour on the way to visit Pearl Harbor and the Arizona Memorial Visitors Center. Once there, view a 20-minute film recalling the events of December 7, 1941 and the history of the famous battleship. After the movie, board a launch to visit the Memorial. Afterwards, the tour will visit the National Cemetery of

the Pacific at beautiful Punchbowl Crater; the most dramatically located site of its kind in the world. Then, drive past the Governor's Mansion, the State Capitol Building, the Royal Palace, and the historic Kawaiaha'o Church, King Kamehameha Statue, Iolani Palace, the only palace on US soil and the home of the last reigning queen of Hawaii, and on to Honolulu's Chinatown, a collection of unique ethnic shops and restaurants reflecting the Chinese and Vietnamese people of Honolulu. Finally, drop off at the Sheraton Waikiki (hotel room charge not included, see "Conference Brochure.") A stop will be made along the way for lunch at one of the waterfront restaurants at Aloha Tower Market.

**Saturday, July 10 (Included in Friday's rate)**

Pickup at the Sheraton Waikiki and drop off at the Norwegian Cruise Line pier. \$165 per person rate includes: meet and greet at airport, luggage assistance both days and storage on Friday, transportation via air-conditioned vehicles, guide/escort, lunch on Friday, taxes and gratuities.
